

Who can apply for CalFresh

Any single adult or family who meet the following requirements:

- You must have at least one citizen or legal permanent resident in the household * (including children).
- You are not receiving SSI. Anyone in the household who is receiving SSI is not eligible **BUT** other household members may still qualify!
- You must meet income requirements (if you are disabled, over 60 years of age, or receiving Veterans' Benefits, the table might not apply to you).

* CalFresh considers a household anyone who buys and prepares food together.

What are the income requirements?

Monthly income limits per household must be below the amounts listed below.

People in Household	Gross Monthly Income	Net Monthly Income

What do I need to apply?

Required Documents:

- Photo ID for all Adults

If Applicable:

- Social Security Number for all members of the household who have one
- Proof of income (pay stubs, letter from employer, benefits letter, etc.)
- Proof of living expenses (rent, utility bills, phone bills, etc.)
- Verification of child or dependent care expenses
- Verification of any medical expenses (if elderly/disabled member in the household)
- Proof of Residency or Immigration Status (for non-US citizens)
